TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2021 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

Alternative route is via: Burnham Road, Creake Road, Station Road, Church Walk, Docking Road, Stanhoe Road, Bircham Road, Stocks Close, Lynn Road, Anmer Road, Hillington Road, Fakenham Road, The Green, Syderstone Road, Tattersett Road, Bloodgate Hill, Bluestone Road, Church Street (Hillington/ Burnham Market/ West Rudham/ Docking/ Tattersett/ Flitcham with Appleton/ Harpley/ North Creake/ South Creake/ Bircham/ East Rudham/ Burnham Thorpe/ Barwick/ Anmer/ Stanhoe/ Syderstone).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
