1. **Welcome by the Chairman at 7.00 pm.**

2. **To receive apologies for absence**

4. **Meeting Adjourned by Chairman at 7.05pm**

5. **The meeting reconvened by the Chairman at approximately 7.06 pm.**

6. **To approve the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 12th November 2018**

The minutes were **AGREED** by the Council and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

7. **Matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held on Monday 12th November 2018**

All matters were covered on the agenda.

8. **Report from Wicken Green Village Management Committee**

Mark White from the WGVMV gave a report, covering the following items.

- Lancaster Road – Tree work is to be undertaken 25-26 Feb. 12 Leylandii to be reduced to 3 metres
- New road name signs to be put up for the entire village.

9. **Speeding through The Street and Lancaster Road.**

Sharon McKendrick said that safety strips had been put down but in the wrong position. They should have been near the school.

There was no news as yet with regard to the funding for the white gates that Linda Arthur has applied for, although this is expected in March.

Meeting Adjourned by Chairman to hear from Cllr Tom Fitzpatrick who arrived at 7.20pm

- **(Item 9 Speeding Issues)** Cllr Fitzpatrick AGREED to get funding for a change to 20mph limit outside the school in Lancaster Road.
Speeding through Tatterford – the approach road into the village has 3 blind bends. We are on the waiting list for speed monitoring. Cllr Fitzpatrick AGREED to follow this up.
- **(Item 12) Fourwinds Junction** Cllr Fitzpatrick reported that this was number 25 on the waiting list for a roundabout. As there had not been an accident reported there for 3 years it was not considered a priority. Several Councillors reported to him that there had in fact been an accident there today. Cllr Fitzpatrick assured the Parish Council that he was doing his utmost to support this.
- **(Item 16 Tyre Mountain)** Cllr Fitzpatrick informed the Council that Mr Gawn would have to start to bale the tyres otherwise action would be taken. The Vice-Chair read a letter from Mr Gawn which states that he has taken the first steps to remove the tyres. However, this has not happened.
The Chair suggested a site meeting, to which the Press would be invited. Mark White asked that he should be involved in any such meeting.
- **(Item 14 Houses in Sterling Road)** Cllr Fitzpatrick agreed to follow this up.
- Cllr Fitzpatrick reported that he had put in a bid for funding for broadband for all County schools. Hopefully rural areas would benefit from this. He informed that Council that it was very important that parishioners should register interest on the County website, as well as registering with Openreach.
- Cllr Fitzpatrick spoke about County Council budgets, including a 3% increase in council tax.

The meeting reconvened by the Chairman at approximately 7.50 pm.
